# GOTEACH MENU OF OPPORTUNITIES

## WHAT IS GOTEACH?

GoTeach UK is the partnership between the DHL UK Foundation and DHL business, who are working together to support young people across the UK who really need our help. The programme offers DHL colleagues, irrespective of location, job role or experience, the opportunity to:

- Inspire young people about the world of work
- Showcase DHL and the wide range of careers available in the logistics industry
- Raise aspirations, develop confidence and help young people prepare for employment
- Support local communities by connecting DHL colleagues and sites with their local schools

## GOTEACH UK TOOLKIT

The GoTeach UK toolkit provides you with all of the materials, content and resources you need to deliver any of the activities and sessions. You will be fully briefed and trained ahead of any session and supported on the day by a member of the DHL UK Foundation team.

### Classroom Activities

A short assembly or lesson delivered by a DHL colleague in a school. The activities are designed to inspire pupils, showcase DHL, and introduce students to career opportunities in the logistics industry.

2 hours of classroom activity + 2 hours preparation time

### Site Visit

Hosting students for an interactive Site Visit at a local DHL site or office. This includes a site tour, careers Q&A with DHL colleagues, and logistics-themed problem solving and teamwork activities.

2-4 hours + preparation time

### Employability Skills Workshop

A practical and engaging workshop designed to help students develop employability skills. It is an opportunity for colleagues to showcase their own transferable skills and role within logistics, delivered in the classroom.

2-3 hours + 1-2 hours of preparation

### Mentoring

Using your skills and experience to support and mentor a young person or newly qualified teacher.

Mentoring requires you to make a regular commitment of around 1-2 hours per month.

### Outdoor Learning

Colleagues support young people to develop their skills through an unforgettable outdoor educational residential experience with The Outward Bound Trust.

6 days residential + 1 day mentor training + pre and post residential school activities.

### CV & Interview Skills Workshop

A hands-on workshop designed to assist students with CV writing and interview techniques delivered in the classroom.

3 hours + 1 hour preparation

### Work Experience and Employability through Sport

An opportunity to engage with unemployed young people through football, dance and fitness and help them recognise the transferable skills these sports offer.

3 hours + 1 hour preparation

### Trucks and Child Safety (TACS)

An interactive session educating children between the ages of 7 and 11 years old about road safety and the dangers of large vehicles in their local communities, delivered in primary schools across the UK.

1 day at school + 1 day of preparation. Demonstrators are asked to give 3 demonstrations per year.
