

ACTIVITY:

SITE VISIT

What is the activity?

Hosting students for an interactive Site Visit at a local DHL site or office. This includes a site tour, careers Q&A with DHL colleagues, and logistics-themed problem solving and teamwork activities.

Typical activity structure:

1. Start with an introduction and overview of DHL, your site and customer
2. Run one of the ice-breaker energiser activities provided in the GoTeach Toolkit
3. Split the students into small groups for an engaging and interactive tour of the site
4. Give students the opportunity to meet colleagues with a variety of roles
5. Run one of the teamwork and problem solving activities from the Toolkit for the students
6. Encourage the students to ask questions



Did you know?

Students will be inspired by the range of roles available and how colleagues have progressed within DHL, so why not introduce them to a DHL Apprentice or Graduate?



Hint ★

Use your site's training space or meeting room space to run one of the teamwork and problem solving activities provided in the GoTeach Toolkit. This helps make the day fun and memorable for the students and reinforces their learning.




The Site Visit at DHL gave us a chance to see how the different departments worked together, a concept which was previously quite abstract. This has given me a valuable insight into how business works.

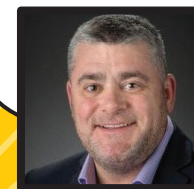
Did you know?
